

Update Rimage Software Suite with a Service Pack


To keep your Rimage system running at peak performance, update your software to the most current version. The procedure in this document is for Rimage systems using Producer or OfficeNet Software Suites.

 **Notes:**

- For instructions on updating service packs for systems using Rimage 2000i Software, refer to the *Update Rimage Desktop Software with a Service Pack* document available on www.rimage.com/support.
- Unless otherwise indicated, all Windows navigation statements in this document are Windows XP paths. Windows 2000 and Windows Vista paths may differ slightly.


Software Update Procedure

1. Download the latest **service pack** from www.rimage.com/support.
 - a. From the **Support** menu select: **Product Series > Your Product > Software, Firmware & Service Packs** tab.
 - b. Select the link to the latest **service pack** for your product. The **Service Pack Download** page displays.
